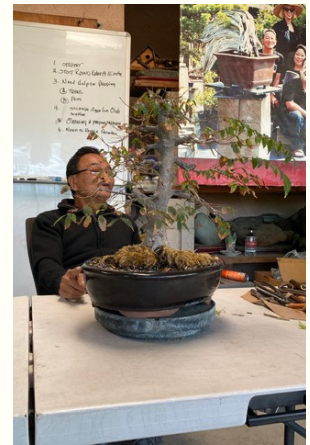

NOVEMBER MEETING

Tree Workshop and Demonstration - David Nguy



Sensei David Nguy helped members with their own trees. Member Jorge brought a Japanese Maple and Zelkora. Sensei David adjusted the front and cut some thick branches on the Japanese Maple for better form. He also recommended light fertilization for the tree. On the Zelkora, Sensei David noticed the burnt leaf tips indicating that the soil is too wet for this tree. Member Robert brought a Seagreen Juniper. Sensei David adjusted the front and recommended bringing some branches down. Sensei David also suggested he could graft to Shimpaku.

Sensei David also took a California Juniper he has been growing for many years and turned into a possible future show tree. Please see pictures below of the awesome transformation.
