AUGUST MEETING

Tree presentation and preparation for the show - David Nguy







Sensei David Nguy discussed how to properly present a bonsai tree and what is needed to be a part of the Chino Bonsai Club 2nd Annual Bonsai Exhibit. All trees should be well established in a pot prior to the show to stay healthy and to avoid damage during transport. All trees need a stand or slab and accent plants need a stand or slab as well. Accent plants should contrast and not be taller than the lowest branch of the bonsai tree. The accent plant should not have the same shape pot as the bonsai tree. Bonsai tree and accent plant should point towards each other. Start mossing trees now and keep in shade and well watered. With a three point display, trees should face each other, be of different species and contrast each other. In the three point display, the two trees should be on the outside with the accent plant in the middle. For two shohin displays on one table, a bamboo divider should be used to separate them.
